The main aim of this institution is to impart technical education among the rural youths. PLACEMENT DAY CELEBRATION

Placement Day was celebrated on 22nd March 2017. The chief Guest Mr .Gandhimathinathan, Vice President, HR & OHS, Bradken India Ltd, Coimbatore delivered the keynote speech. Mr.S.S.Muthuvelappan, Senior Vice President-HR, Sakthi Sugars Ltd. Coimbatore, Mr. Sezhian , Senior General Manager, Sakthi Sugars Ltd., addressed the students and distributed the appointment orders to the students. A total of 49 companies have visited our college for campus recruitment. The number of students placed through campus placement programs is on the rise every year. Based on the data furnished below with respect to campus placements, it may be observed that almost 90% of the eligible students got placements in reputed companies that have visited the campus for recruitments. A total of 463 students got placement from 2016-2017 batch, securing 858 offers.415 students received multiple offers.
