## **DIPLOMA COURSES RULES & REGULATIONS**

### **Procedure for Continuing the Courses**

Candidates joining the Diploma Courses will complete the courses of study in three academic years without break.

### **Eligibility to appear for Board Examination**

A Minimum of 80% attendance is required separately in Theory, Drawing and Practical classes to appear for the Board Examination. Students who do not put in the minimum attendance will not be allowed to appear for the Board examinations.

### **Criteria for Pass:**

A candidate shall be declared to have passed the examination in a subject, if he/she secures not less than 40% in theory subjects and 50% in practical subjects out of the total prescribed maximum marks including both the Internal Assessment and the Board Examinations marks put together, subject to the condition that he/she secures at least a minimum of 40 marks out of 100 marks in the Board Theory Examinations.

### **“N” SCHEME WITH EFFECT FROM 2021-2022**

#### **EXAMINATIONS**

1. The First year Examination is conducted in semester pattern under ‘N’ Scheme from the Academic year 2021-2022. The First Semester will extend from July / August to December and the Second Semester from January to May.
2. A candidate shall be declared to have passed the Examination in a subject if he / she secures not less than 40% in Theory Subjects and 50% in the Practical Subjects in the Boards Examination out of the total prescribed maximum marks including the sessional and Board Examination marks put together.
3. For a pass in Theory subject including Drawing a candidate should secure a minimum of 40 marks out of the maximum Examination marks of 100 in the Board Examination.
4. A minimum of 50 marks out of 100 in the Board Examination is required for a pass in respect of Practical subjects.

### **Classification of Successful Candidates:**

Classification of candidates who pass out the final examinations from April 2023 onwards (Joined in first year in 2020-2021) will be done as specified below;

**First Class with Superlative Distinction:**

A candidate will be declared to have passed in First Class with Superlative Distinction if he/she secures not less than 75% of the marks in all the subjects and passes all the semesters in the first appearance itself and passes all subjects within the stipulated period of study 3 years without any break in study.

**First Class with Distinction:**

A candidate will be declared to have passed in First Class with Distinction if he/she secures not less than 75% of the aggregate marks in all the semesters put together and passes all the semesters except the I and II semester in the first appearance itself and passes all subjects within the stipulated period of study 3 years without any break in study.

**First Class:**

A candidate will be declared to have passed in First Class if he/she secures not less than 60% of the aggregate marks in all the semesters put together and passes all the subjects within the stipulated period of study 3 years without any break in study.

**Second Class:**

All other successful candidates will be declared to have passed in Second Class.

## GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

1. The Conduct of each students should be satisfactory.
2. Students should wear uniforms everyday.
3. Students should be punctual to the classes and attend to their work with devotion. A students can not leave or enter the classroom at his own will. Those who do not have classes shall engage themselves in study in the library.
4. Damage of any kind done to the college property will be viewed seriously and disciplinary action will be taken against the student. The cost of the same will be recovered from the erring students. Students should maintain the college property as their own. This refers to the maintenance of college buildings, furniture, Equipment, Electrical fittings, Library books, Drawing rooms etc.
5. Tampering with any college property is open to appropriate action.
6. Students should acquaint themselves with the notification put up in the Notice board.
7. malpractice and misbehaviour will be considered discourteous and will be viewed seriously.
8. No meeting should be organised without getting prior permission from the principal.
9. Usage of cell phones by the students is strictly prohibited inside the college premises.
10. Day - Scholars are not allowed to enter the hostel without prior permission from the principal.
11. Breach of any of the above rules will lead to disciplinary action resulting in suspension or expulsion of the student.

## DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS

1. A complaint by the student shall be in writing and signed by the Complainant, shall set out the grounds of the complaint, to the class teacher/Tutor/or to any staff member.
2. The staff member, other than the class teacher, shall submit the complaint to the Class teacher / tutor for further action.
3. The Class teacher (a) may ask the Complainant to supply such further information and documents in his possession/ custody or relating to the complaint;  
(b) shall invite the Respondent to submit to the Council in writing any explanation of his conduct or of any other matter alleged in the complaint which he may have to offer.
4. The HOD will verify the authenticity of the statement made by the complainant / respondent and may dismiss the matter or using his discretion refer the matter to the Disciplinary Panel.
5. The function of the Disciplinary Committee is to decide whether a complaint has been proved in light of the facts before it and, if so, to determine the sanction which ought to be imposed.
6. The parties shall submit written Cases setting out their respective submissions on all material matters and annexing all documentary evidence on which they rely.
7. The initial burden of proof is upon the Complainant.
8. The strict rules of evidence do not apply; the Disciplinary Committee may receive any material, and attach such weight to that material, as it considers appropriate.
9. If any party fails or refuses to make submissions or answer questions on any matter or issue, the Disciplinary Committee shall be entitled to draw an adverse inference against that party.
10. Disciplinary Committee will present their findings with recommendations to the principal/Chairman, Board of Enquiry for further action.
