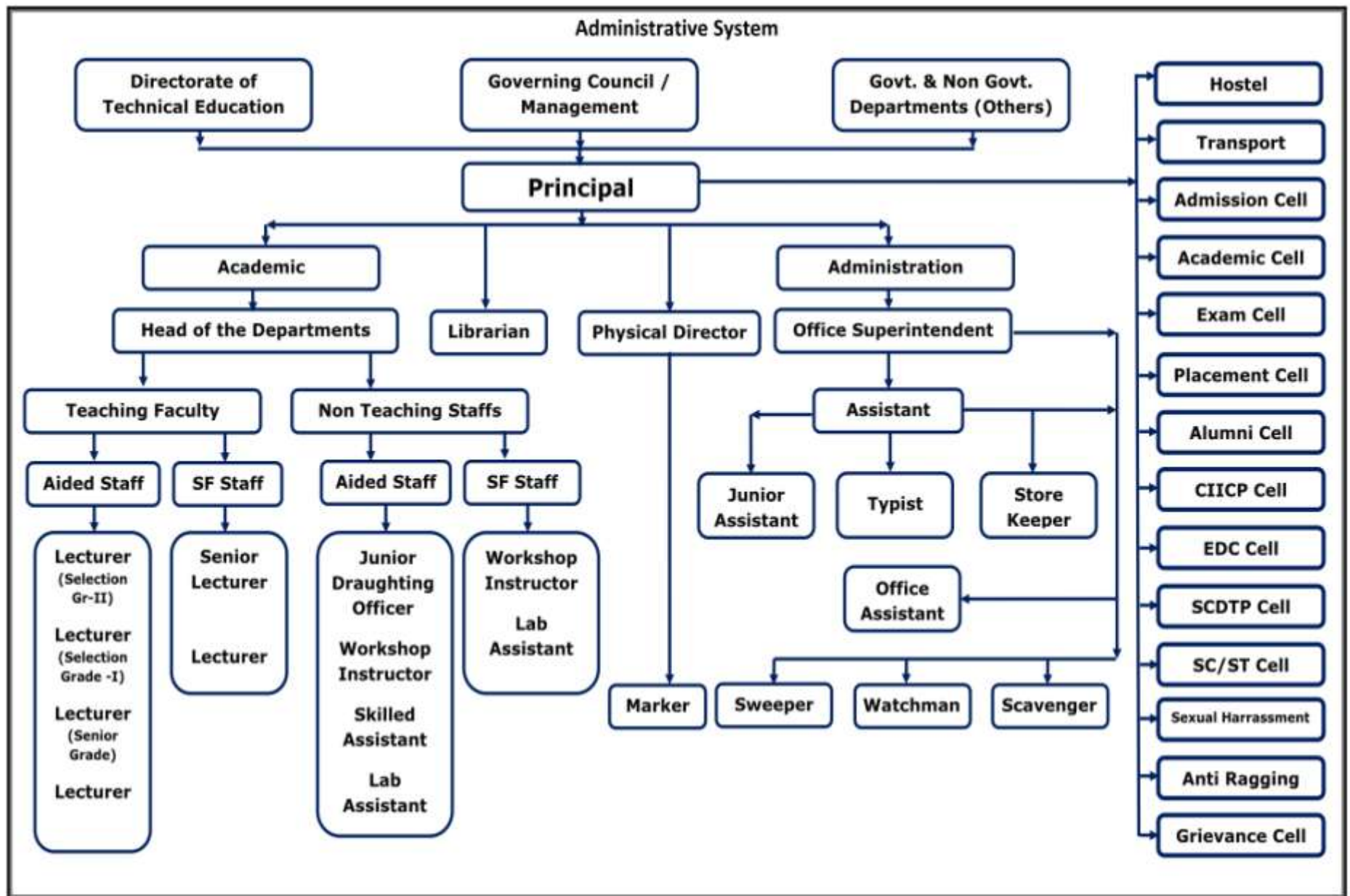

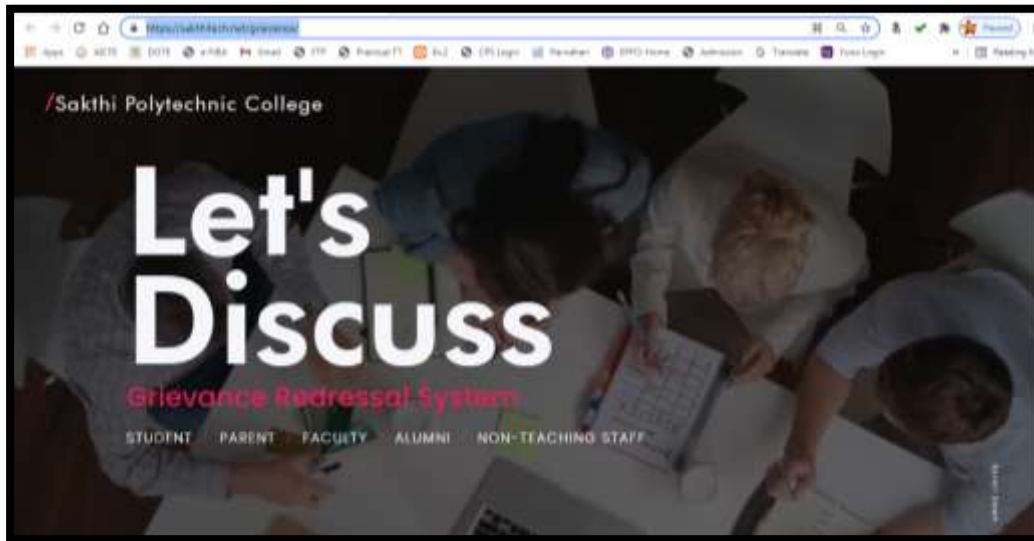

5. Constitution of the Admission Committee

The Principal shall constitute an Admission Committee comprising:

- ❖ Office Superintendent/Administrative Officer – Member
- ❖ Admission Coordinator – Member Secretary

The DOTE nominee oversees the entire admission process and certifies that admissions are conducted strictly according to Government norms.

6. Scrutiny by the DOTE Nominee

The nominee appointed by DOTE shall:

- ❖ Verify eligibility conditions.
- ❖ Examine the merit list and reservation roster.
- ❖ Ensure that no unauthorized admissions are made.
- ❖ Confirm that admissions are strictly on merit and communal reservation principles.
- ❖ Record observations in the admission proceedings register.
- ❖ Endorse the final admission list with signature and date.

Any deviation observed by the nominee shall be immediately reported to DOTE.

7. Conduct of Counseling and Seat Allotment

The Admission Committee, in the presence of the DOTE nominee, shall:

- ❖ Call candidates according to merit rank.

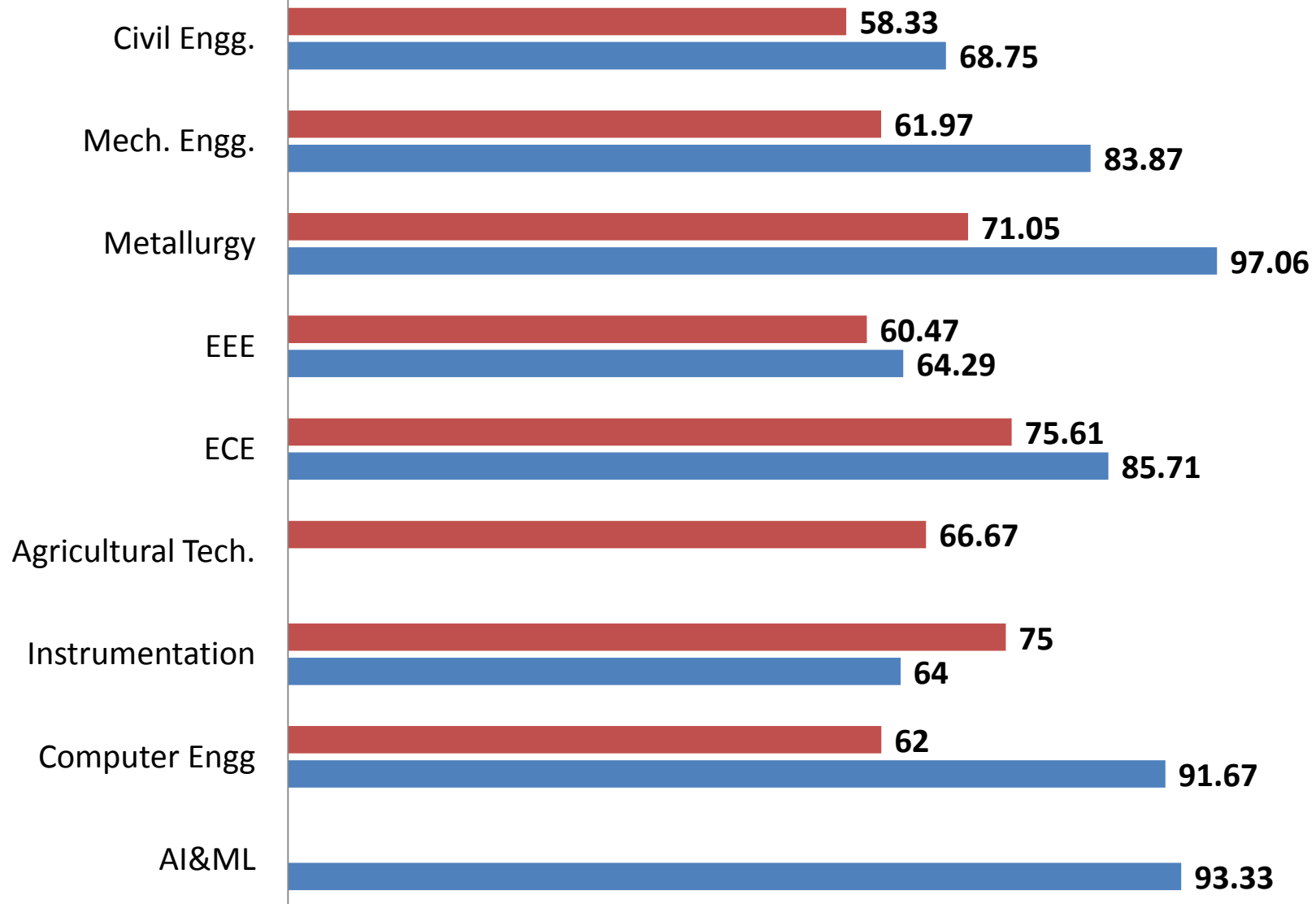

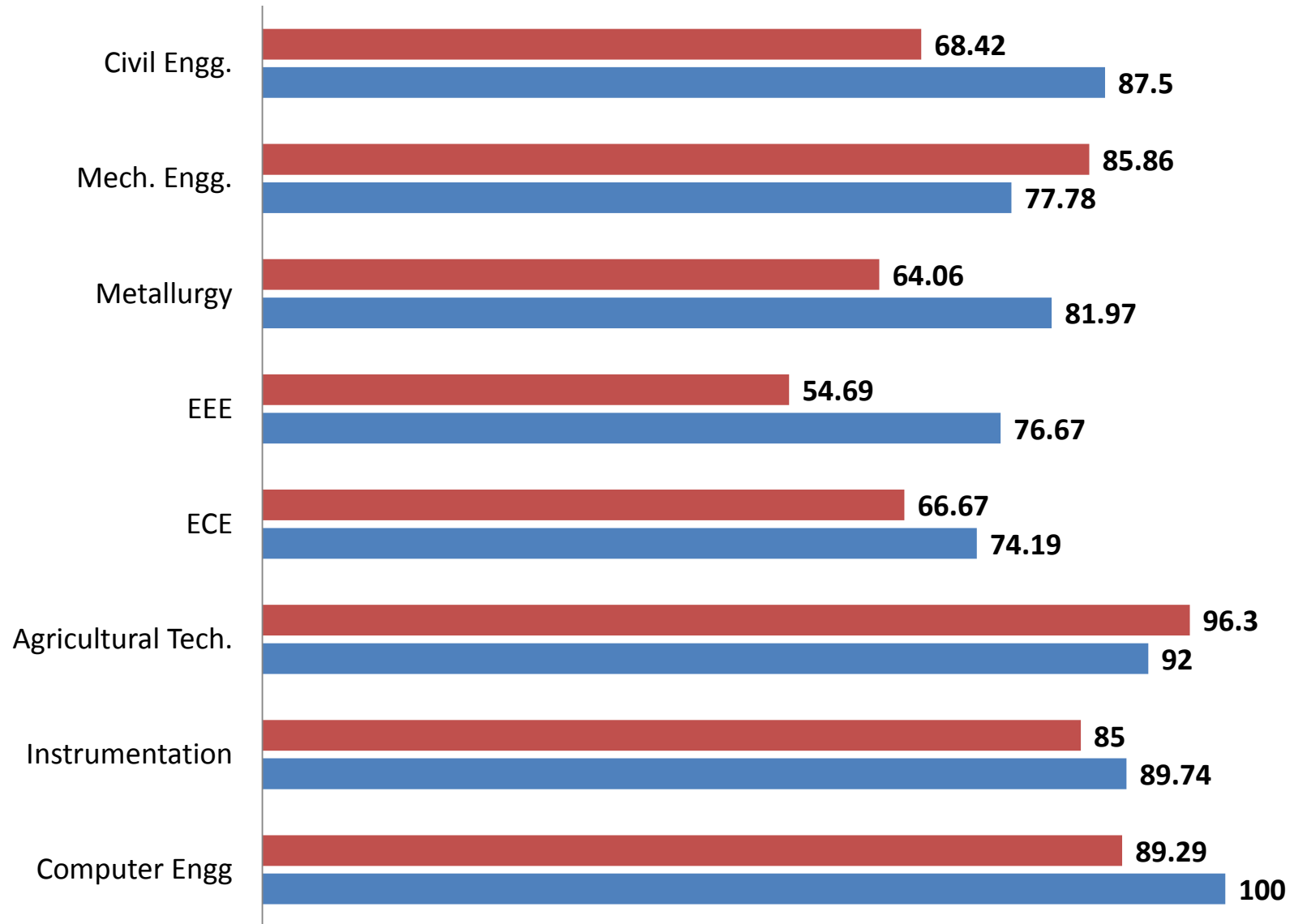
First Year pass percentage

■ April 2025 (65.98%) ■ April 2026 (82.11%)



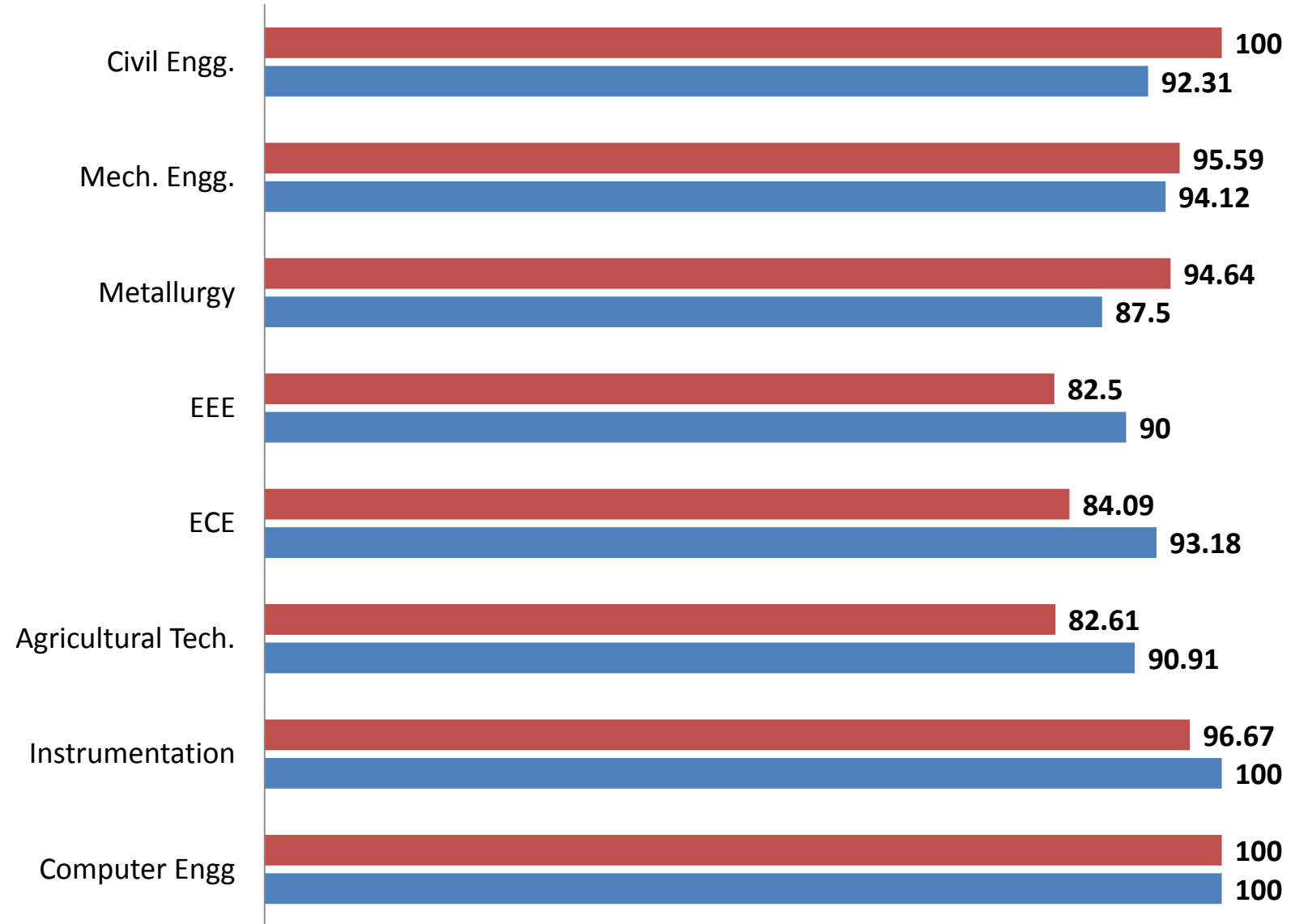
Second Year pass percentage

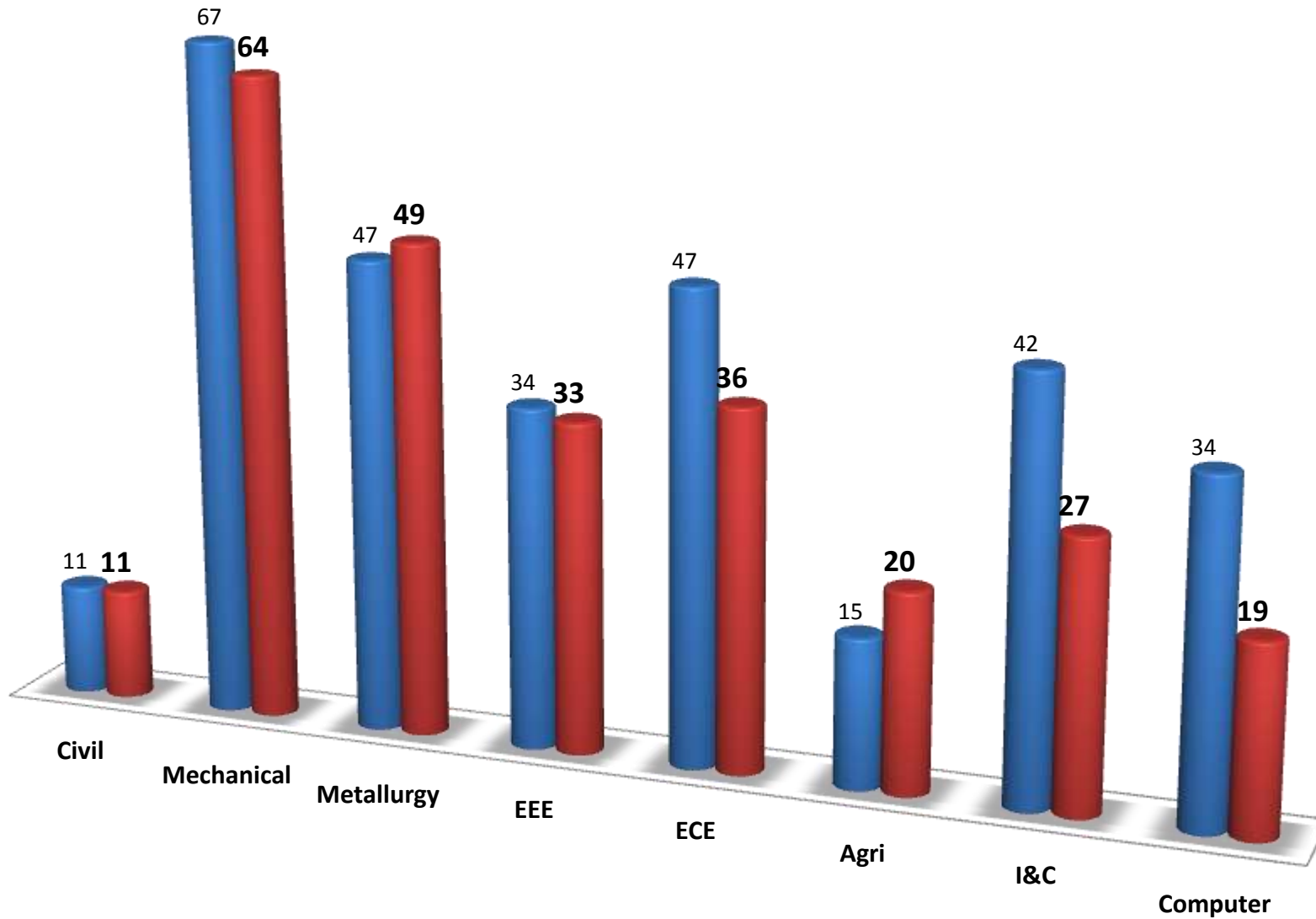

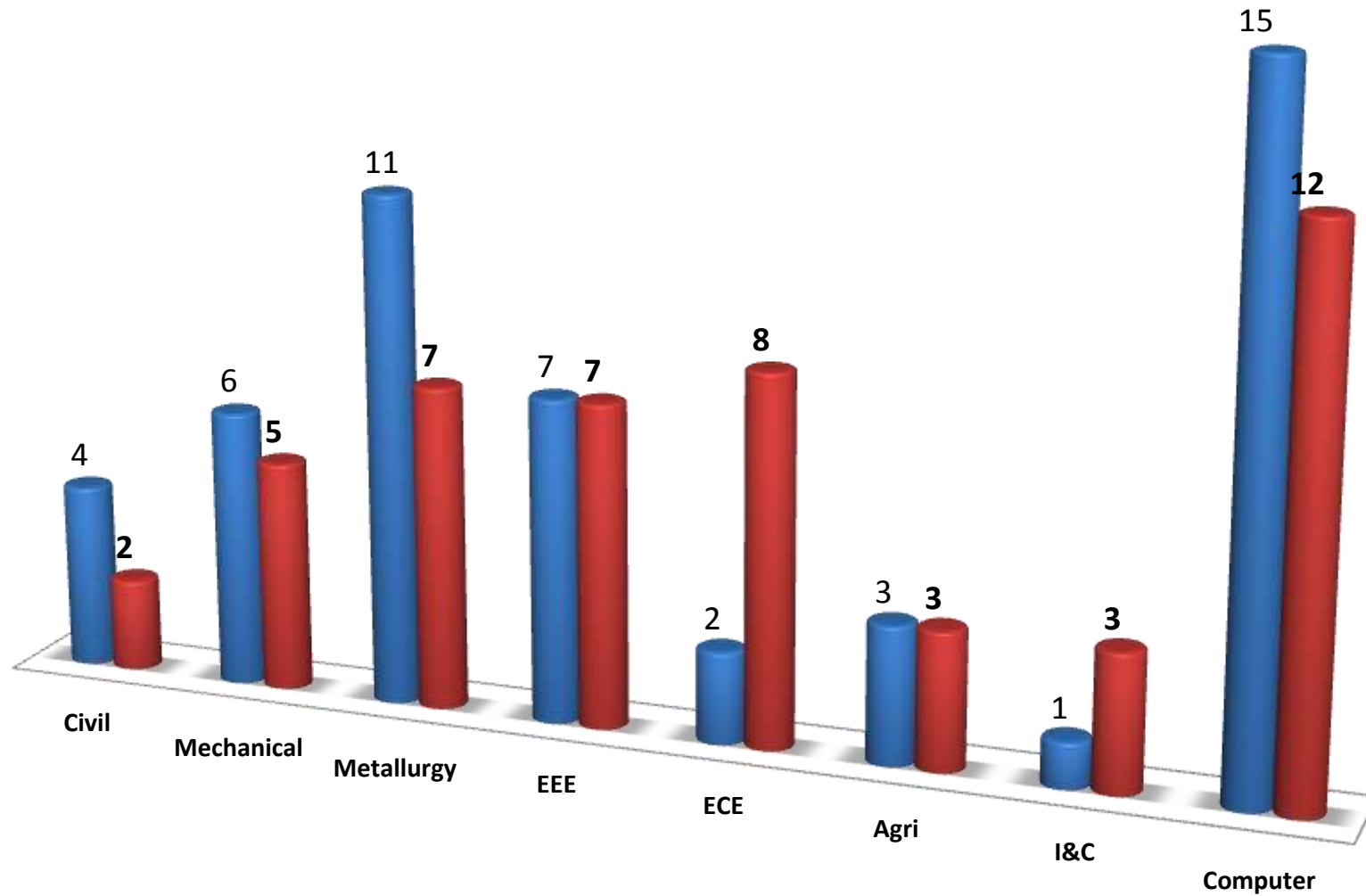
No.of.Students Placed

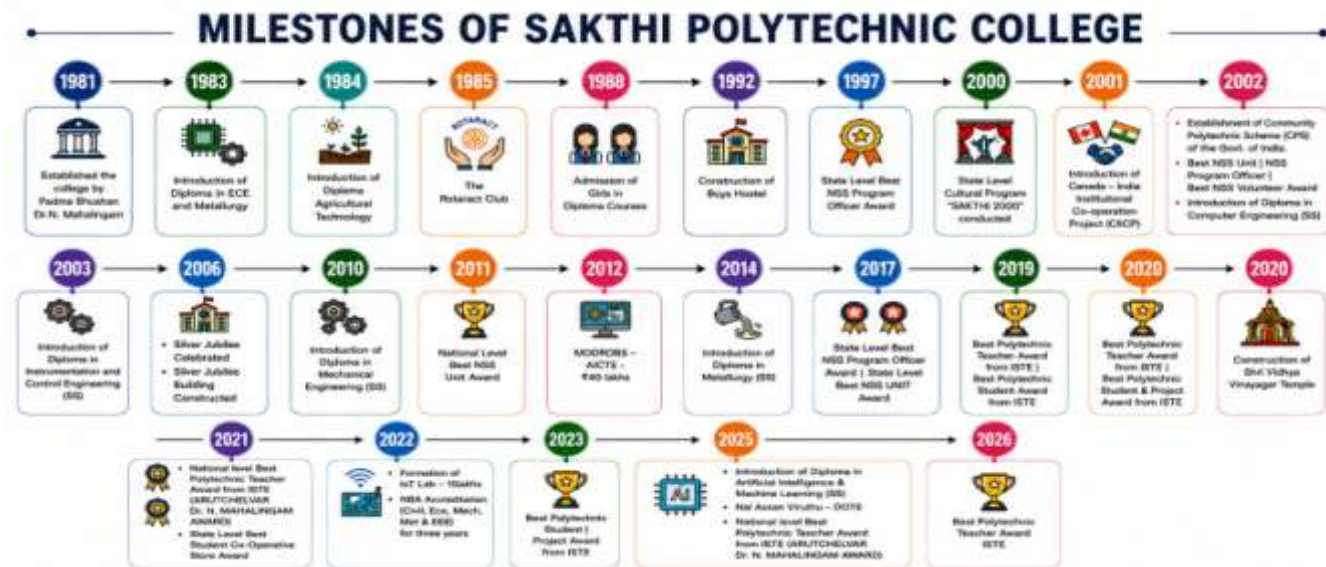
