1.TREE PLANTATION – 17.11.2025

Introduction

To combat environmental degradation and contribute to the national green cover, the NCC Unit of Sakthi Polytechnic College organized a massive Tree Plantation Drive on November 17, 2025. Recognizing the critical need for climate action, the drive was structured to instill environmental consciousness among youth and turn the institutional campus into a model ecosystem.

Objectives of the Event

- To increase the green cover on the college campus and surrounding community zones.
- To educate cadets on the role of trees in reducing carbon footprints, preventing soil erosion, and conserving groundwater.
- To foster long-term environmental responsibility among students by assigning ownership for tree maintenance.

Execution & Key Activities

- **Procurement of Saplings:** A variety of native, shade-giving, and herbal saplings—including Neem, Punga, Gulmohar, and Teak—were sourced to ensure high survival rates in the local climate.
- **Plantation Process:** The cadets were organized into working pairs. They dug pits, applied organic manure, planted the saplings safely, and watered them.
- **Target Areas:** The drive focused heavily on the college sports ground borders, the pathways leading to the student hostels, and barren patches near the institution's boundaries.
- **Protective Measures:** To protect the young plants from cattle and harsh weather, cadets installed eco-friendly guards and tree-fenders around each sapling.

Outcome & Impact

The plantation drive was a grand success, resulting in the planting of numerous native saplings across the designated areas. Beyond the immediate physical activity, the event created a deep sense of environmental stewardship. To ensure the project's sustainability, individual cadets volunteered to monitor and water specific saplings throughout their academic terms.
